STUDENT REGULATIONS

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. The official language of the school is Polish.
2. Students are expected to behave respectfully at all times, showing courtesy to teachers, school staff, and fellow classmates.
3. Education at the Polish school follows a set curriculum and class schedule provided to students.
4. Students are required to actively participate in all classes, which means:
 - arriving to school on time,
 - entering the classroom with their teacher,
 - leaving the classroom for recess or after school only with the permission of the teacher or principal,
 - following teachers' instructions during lessons and breaks,
 - bringing the necessary textbooks and school supplies, maintaining neat notebooks, and participating in all assessments,
 - paying attention during class and carefully listening to homework assignments in order to complete them independently,
 - always sitting in their assigned seat and taking care of their desk and classroom materials.

REWARDS:

- verbal praise from the teacher in front of the class and parents,
- excellent grades,
- certificates,
- awards and special recognition in front of the school community and parents,
- honorary awards.

STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO:

- enter the school building alone, walk around the classroom, or leave it without the teacher's permission,
- bring items unrelated to school activities,
- arrive at school on bicycles, skateboards, or roller skates,
- use cell phones or other electronic devices on school premises (in case of emergency, the student may use the teacher's or principal's phone).
